

Guidelines for Abstract Submission
22ND ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC RELATIONS RESEARCH CONFERENCE
Orlando, Florida, USA, March 7-9, 2019

Authors should send a **two-page, MSWord document**.

On the **FIRST PAGE**, please indicate the following information **only**:

1. Indicate whether your submission is either “**research-in-progress**” or “**completed research**”
2. Indicate whether your submission is either “**student**” (students only) or “**general**” (faculty, practitioner, faculty-student or faculty-practitioner collaborative) submission
3. Paper title
4. All author names and affiliations, listed in the order as they appear on the paper
5. Corresponding author and email address (for whom paper-related communication will be sent)
 - a. Note: All authors will continue to receive conference-related information
6. 50-word short abstract (this abstract is for the conference program book)

On the **SECOND PAGE**, please provide a **BLIND** copy of your submission, which includes:

1. Indications of two categories:
 - a. “research-in-progress” or “completed research”
 - b. “student” or “general” submission
2. Paper title
3. Abstract content
4. If you need to include citations, please list them in footnote within **the same** page using either APA or MLA style.
5. Please note that any author identification information must be eliminated from the second page.
6. Abstracts can be **either single-spaced or double-spaced and should be printed in 12-point, Times New Roman with 1" margins**.
